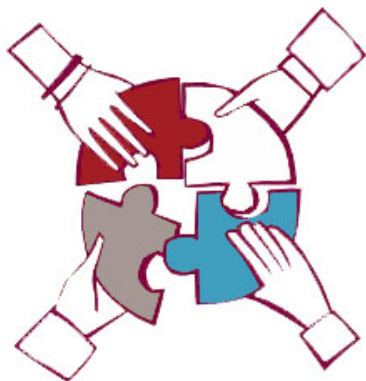

The mission of Kansas City CARE Clinic is to promote health and wellness by providing quality care, access, research and education to the underserved and all people in our community.

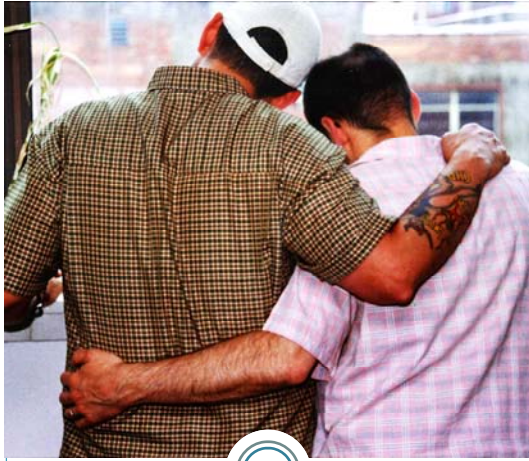
We accomplish our mission by:

SERVICES OFFERED:

WHAT IS CASE MANAGEMENT?

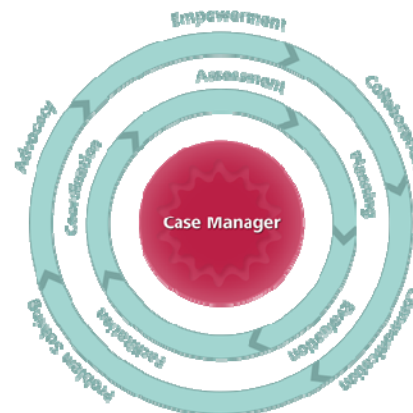
Case Management at the Kansas City CARE Clinic is a program in which case managers and participants work together to achieve goals.

HOW DO I GET INVOLVED IN THE PROGRAM?

Case management services are available at enrollment or by asking for a referral from your therapist. Case Management is only available to participants who are enrolled in Behavioral Health Services at the Kansas City CARE Clinic.

WHAT DOES CASE MANAGEMENT ENTAIL?

Case managers and participants will meet together on a regular basis to gather information on individual needs and desires. Case managers and participants then develop a plan of action to work toward meeting those needs and desires, put that plan into action, and then meet regularly to talk about progress and reassess new needs as they come up.



WHAT DO CASE MANAGERS DO?

Advocate: Case Managers often speak on behalf of the participants when they are unable to speak for themselves, or when participants feel their voice is not being heard.

Broker: Case Managers link participants to needed services in the community after gathering information.

Coordinate: Case Managers work with other professionals in the agency to provide services in the best and quickest way.

Plan: Case Managers and clients work together to come up with a plan to solve arising problems.

Support: Case Managers provide professional support and encouragement to help participants achieve goals.
