

Jennifer’s Story:

Jennifer came to the Kansas City CARE Clinic as a victim of sexual abuse. She was diagnosed with major depression and post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). Through the Clinic’s Behavioral Health program, Jennifer was able to access psychiatric services, case management, individual and group therapy. Her condition stabilized and she secured employment with health insurance.

Then, in the recent economic downturn, Jennifer was laid off. Without health insurance, she could not afford the price of her medications, but she also knew it was no time to do without them. Jennifer returned to the Clinic to preserve her mental health. With the help of case management, psychiatry and medication services, she has secured a new job with health insurance and is now pursuing a Master’s degree.
